1. Pl check whether your school is registered on the web site. If not, register your school by registering one student with all the relevant information related to your school <http://www.ihavereadthebook.com/signupForm>

If one student is registered on the website then School related information is already available for other students of the school.

2. Encourage the children to register on the web-site. **There is no cost for registration.** <http://www.ihavereadthebook.com/signupForm>

3. Each student will have his/her page on the website.

4. Suggest them to read at least 5 books and write reviews on the website. For each review the child will get the points. Based on the number of reviews written the student will be upgraded to various levels of ABC membership.
